2.4 BUGS FIXED IN THIS VERSION

 Downloader firmware version 0.0 caused the processor to enter download mode and never leave, deleting the application firmware and causing the ARU fans to operate at full speed. To avoid this issue, upgrade the downloader firmware to version 1.0, then upgrade the ARU application to firmware version 3.1.5a.
